Activate Dunne Park Project

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS FOR DUNNE PARK

Priorities were developed from 2 Neighborhood Workshops, held in February & March 2018, and several City staff meetings

Safety & Security- Increase police presence; activate Adobe building

- 1. Renovate office space at Adobe Building
- 2. Recreation Dept. to use office for PAL sign-ups and other activities; other City Depts. to use office, such as file police reports

Park Improvements- Increase accessibility, comfort and usage

- 3. Demolish BBQ area; replace with grassy slope
- 4. Install 3 small picnic areas throughout park; use trees as shade
- 5. Create Diagonal Parking on 7th Street (south side)
- 6. Create shade structure at baseball field (dugouts only)
- 7. Add new recreation feature:
 - a. Install ping pong tables to West end of tennis courts (other ideas included water feature, basketball court)
 - b. Add artist design to ping pong tables

Park Improvements- Increase attractiveness, accessibility and sense of "place"

- 8. Commission crosswalk design mid-block on 7th (between Powell & West) that references neighborhood features
- 9. Plant 25 trees
- 10. Install artist-designed benches in designated locations (4 benches)
- 11. Install Chess boards in Rose Garden or at new picnic locations
- 12. Include option for Memorial Benches
- 13. Partner with Master Gardner Program; 4H/Boy Scouts/Girl Scouts
- 14. Activate park through Summer Programming (see page 2)
